

Virginia State University's Small Farm Outreach Program offers workshops and courses to help beginning and established small farmers make smart decisions about their farm businesses.

Find out what you need to know for tax planning, record-keeping and marketing as well as strategies for reducing risk and connecting to available funding through state and federal agencies—all designed to help you grow and sustain a successful farm business.

AGRIBUSINESS & FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

Especially for limited resource farmers, this six-part course is designed to meet the mandatory USDA/FSA financial and production management borrower training requirements, assist in boosting farm profitability and income for farm families and local communities, and offer hands-on training to develop valuable skills in financial management and crop production. (2-Day Course, \$50 fee)

NEW FOR 2017! USDA NRCS STRIKEFORCE COUNTIES WORKSHOPS

Each month from January-June, Small Farm Outreach Agents and representatives from USDA Natural Resource and Conservation Service (NRCS) will host a local demonstration workshop that provides information on available NRCS programs and opportunities as well as a variety on-site educational demonstrations on topics including drip irrigation, high tunnel production, no-till vs. conventional farming, and pasture grazing.

BEGINNING FARMER WHOLE FARM PLANNING

Instructors from Virginia State University's Small Farm Outreach Program include agents Derrick Cladd, Alvin Adkins and Patrick Johnson. Together, they are very familiar with most agricultural education opportunities across Virginia and can show new farmers where to get the help they need for any farming enterprise.

TAX PLANNING & RURAL DEVELOPMENT USDA GRANT PROGRAMS

Designed for anyone who will be preparing 2016 income tax returns for farmers and farm owners. Important information on farm-related tax topics will be presented by a CPA and tax expert. Stay up-to-date with new tax regulations and requirements that may impact your farm business. In addition, you will learn about the application process for USDA programs including Rural Energy for America and the Value Added Producer Grant.

ESTATE PLANNING AND FARM TRANSITION

If a farm or ranch family business has not adequately planned for changes in ownership, it is more likely to go out of business, be absorbed into ever-larger farming neighbors, or be converted to non-farm uses. This workshop will provide information and guidance on the decisions you can make today to help you plan and achieve financial and personal goals for the future!
