

Virginia Soil & Water Conservation Districts

- Districts political subdivisions of the state within the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR)
 - manage conservation programs
 - employ staff and deliver conservation services free of charge
- Main focus is nonpoint source pollution







Natural Resource Conservation Service

- Natural Resource Conservation Service
 - Improvements to the land that you own/lease
 - Offers technical and financial assistance to famers, ranchers and forest managers



 NRCS's natural resources conservation programs help people reduce soil erosion, enhance water supplies, improve water quality, increase wildlife habitat, and reduce damages caused by floods and other natural disasters.
